TUTORIAL CHEAT SHEET // SOFT & HARD EDGES WITH LASSO TOOL

BRUSHSET

[SPELLBOOK AIRBRUSH BY DAVEMH](#) // This brushset features various noisy airbrushes that are ideal for this technique. It can be imported into both Photoshop and Procreate.

KEY LESSONS

- How to **combine the lasso / selection tool** with a soft brush or gradient to paint
- **Specific benefits** of the lasso / selection tool over painting with a brush
- How to **alternate between soft and hard edges** to gradually layer on the detail.

BENEFITS OF LASSO TOOL

01 // EDGE CONTROL

Using the lasso tool allows me to create crisp and clear edges. When combined with textured or noisy brushes, it gives the best of both worlds.

02 // LAYERING DETAIL

Because this technique creates semi-translucent shapes, you can layer on the detail gradually without totally covering up the layer below.

03 // CONFIDENCE

Because the selection tool is just a placeholder, I find it easier to draw shapes with it. You don't have to commit to the shape until you feel good about it.

TIPS

BE MINDFUL OF MIDTONES

Make sure that the colors you are layering onto your base are not too far apart in value, otherwise you risk getting muddy and unappealing midtones.

EXPERIMENT WITH 'FILLINGS'

You can use a noisy brush to fill the selection shapes like I did, but you can also use other brushes or tools. Experiment until you find something that works for you!

MIX / MATCH WITH OTHER TECHNIQUES

You can use this workflow for one part of your process, and switch to a different workflow for the other parts. I often use this workflow to establish the values and later switch to painting with my brush.
