Blizzard have "no plans" to bring WoW: Shadowlands to console

Speculation of a console port has been hanging around since controller support was datamined earlier this year, and exacerbated by Shadowlands being rated for PC and Xbox Series X in Brazil.

- A Blizzard representative has since confirmed that the classification was an error, and that they currently have no plans for WoW to leave PC. Controller support was just an accessibility option. Better luck next time.



PlayStation Plus reveals unusually timely free games for August

Call of Duty: Modern Warfare 2 Campaign Remaster is available from today, while Twitch sensation Fall Guys: Ultimate Knockout will be available to subscribers on August 4th - the same day as its general release.

- Considering that you need a PlayStation Plus subscription to properly play Fall Guys - it looks like Sony are borrowing Epic's strategy of making new games available for free during their launch window. We'll see how it goes for them.

Looks like Cuphead is headed to PS4

The former Xbox exclusive released on Nintendo Switch last year, and a new PlayStation Store listed looks to have hinted at the platformer's next destination.

- Geoff Keighley is expected to confirm later today, and in other news Cuphead's next DLC pack (The Delicious Last Course) should be ready to drop any day now.

The Witcher is getting a prequel spin-off series on Netflix

Set 1,200 years before Geralt of Rivia, The Witcher: Blood Origin is set to follow the story of the first Witcher across a new six-part series.

- The show will be helmed by Witcher showrunner Lauren Schmidt Hissrich and Declan de Barra, in collaboration with Witcher creator Andrzej Sapkowski. There's no release date just yet.

Eiyuden Chronicle hits funding goal in two hours

The spiritual successor to Suikoden hit Kickstarter yesterday and achieved its goal of \$500K in just two hours - ensuring that the game will release on PC.

- At time of writing the total funding is a massive \$1.5m across 14K backers and, with the \$1m goal met, Eiyuden Chronicle will be headed to PS5, Xbox Series X, and Nintendo Switch.

Ghost of Tsushima update adds new accessibility options

Patch 1.05 releases today, and adds new difficulty options. Lethal difficulty makes every cut count, while a lower intensity option takes the pressure off a bit.


- The update also includes a few text changes - including text size and subtitle colour. Every game these days should have text size options because we're all tired of squinting.

Spider-Man: Miles Morales will reportedly ship with a remastered version of the PS4 title

The latest issue of Game Informer magazine covers June's PS5 event, and states that Miles Morales isn't a traditional sequel because it comes bundled with the first game. Sony are yet to confirm one way or the other.

- Everything we learn about this game somehow makes it more confusing - but a remastered bundle would be a good move from Sony, both as a way to showcase PS5 tech and justify the game's inevitable \$60 price tag.
