# **Pippi Mittens**



#### **ABBREVIATIONS**

yo - yarn over

 ${\bf sk2p}$  - slip next stitch knit-wise, knit 2 stitches together and then pass the slipped stitch over the 2 stitches you knit together

m1r - lift the strand between the 2 needles from back to front and then knit the strand through the front loop

m11-lift the strand between the 2 needles from front to back and then knit the strand through the back loop

**pm** - place marker

sm - slip marker

**k2tog** - knit the next 2 stitches together

#### **NOTIONS**

3.75mm needles for knitting magic loop

1 stitch marker

Tapestry needle

#### **YARN**

Approximately 60g of worsted weight yarn



#### **Left Mitt**

Cast on 40 stitches and join for knitting in the round.

Knit 12 rows of k2, p2 ribbing.

Work 4 repeats (or desired length) of the following pattern -

Rounds 1 to 4 -  $(p1, k3, p1) \times 4$ , knit to end of round.

Round 5 - (p1, yo, sk2p, yo, p1) x 4, knit to end of round.

Round 6 - As round 1

## Thumb gusset

Maintain the pattern repeat on needle 1 and work the following on needle 2 -

Round 1 - knit to last 2 stitches, pm, m1r, k2, m1l.

Round 2 - knit all stitches.

**Round 3** - knit to marker, sm, m1r, knit to end of row, m1l.

Round 4 - knit all stitches.

Repeat rows 3 and 4 until you have 16 stitches following the marker. You will have ended on a round 2 of the pattern repeat.

On the next round remove the 16 thumb stitches onto a piece of waste yarn and then cast on 2 stitches over the gap. I used the backwards loop method to do this.

## Completing the Mitt

You can now continue knitting the pattern on needle 1 and knitting all stitches on needle 2 until you have completed 9 repeats in total.

Knit 6 rows of k2, p2 ribbing and then bind off all stitches. I bound off whilst maintaining the ribbing pattern.

#### **Completing the Thumb**

Put the 16 thumb stitches back onto your needle. Pick up 4 stitches in the gap, 2 of these were the stitches you cast on, plus one either side.

Join yarn and knit until you reach the 4 picked up stitches. You will then k2tog twice, decreasing by 2 stitches (18 stitches).

Knit 5 rows and then work 4 rows of k1, p1 ribbing. Bind off (I bound off in ribbing again).

Weave in ends and use the tail end to close any gaps where you picked up the thumb stitches.
