

Hag Stones



Hag Stones are rare and sacred stones that have a natural occurring hole in it.

They can be any kind of stone and usually can be found alongside dry riverbeds, by the seashore, coastal points and streams. The holes occur from the erosion of the moving water.

They are also known as Witch Stones, Snake Eggs, Hex Stones, Adder Stones, Fairy Stones, Holy Stones, Holey Stones and Eye Stones.

If you find a hag stone, it is considered to be good luck!

It's been said if you find one, you can close one eye and look through hole of the stone to see faeries, spirits and elemental beings.

You can use these stones as protection amulets, new beginnings, cleansing, fertility and opening your third eye.

Hag stones work better if you find one yourself, rather than receiving one as a gift or purchasing one. You can wear one around your neck when you are in nature searching for faeries. If you want to enhance your skills in faery attraction, you can pour morning dew from a container through the hole of your fairy stone before you anoint yourself. If you found your fairy stone in the ocean, you can look through the hole at the water to help you find Sea Spirits, Mermaid and Mermen. If you found your fairy stone in the forest, it can aid in connecting with Tree Spirits. You can suspend a charm of hag stone on a red cord during Samhain, as well, when the veil between the physical world and spirit world is thin.
