Yeah Right.


Do you want to go to JAPAN, tho?

8:05am Shinkansen : Tokyo → Nagano


Reunite again with Dan & Jenna



Nagano's cedar trees remind me of BC




MONKEYS!


Rented Bikes!

at Hiroshima.




**DAY 14**

Kei







I went to a proper art supply store (Sekaido)


