



**Inquisitor Erasmus dark red cloak  
Step-by-step**

# ◆ Paints required:

**Dark red cloak**

- **Khorne red**
- **Abaddon black**
- **Wild rider red**
- **Basic skin tone (Vallejo mc)**







Before we start painting the miniature, we locate the light reflections on cloak, by taking a picture of it under our desk lamp. I primed it in Chaos Black as it has a great shine to it. I have added a guide for how to locate light reflections in the post description.



**We start by basecoating the cloak with a 2:1 mix of khorne red & abaddon black.**



**We now glaze the frame of the light reflections, by adding 1 part more of khorne red to the basecoat mix – add 2 parts of water.**





**We now take pure khorne red & glaze towards the center of the light reflections.**



**We now make a 2:1 mix of khorne red & wild rider red & glaze the center of the light reflections.**





**We now shade the darkest & most shaded areas on the cloak (See reference photo on page 3), by adding 1 part more of abaddon black to the basecoat mix – add 2 parts of water. We furthermore add a 1/2 part more of wild rider red to the previous mix used for the light reflections, & glaze the very center of them.**



**We now add 1/3 part of basic skin tone (A brush tip) to the previous mix & glaze the very center of the light reflections – we furthermore add scratches by painting thin lines & dots with a 2:1 mix of khorne red & wild rider red. Add 1-2 parts of water. Done 😊!**
