TURNAROUND A: C / Bm / A7 // Am7 // G //

VERSE 2: G Am7 Bm G*

CHORUS: F Em Dm C Bb C

Black... bird... fly.....

Pro-tip: This tune may seem complicated, but it's actually very simple. Notice that each of these chords requires only two fingers, and that the same shapes are recycled throughout the composition, for example: Bm and Em are the same exact chord shape being performed on different frets.

Am7 (X,0,X,0,1,X)

Bm (X,2,X,0,3,X)

G* (X,10,X,0,12,X)

C (X,3,X,0,5,X)

C#° (X,4,X,0,0,3)

D (X,5,X,0,7,X)

D#° (x,6,x,0,0,5)

Em (X,7,X,0,8,X)

Eb (X,6,X,0,8,X)

Cm (X,3,X,0,4,X)

A7 (X,0,X,0,2,X)

Am7 (X,0,X,0,1,X)

F (X,8,X,0,10,X)

Em (X,7,X,0,8,X)

Dm (X,5,X,0,6,X)

Bb (X,1,X,0,3,X)
