DR. MASON

Dr. Mason hails from Washington Heights in Chicago. After his father's death, Mason was raised by his mother and his paternal uncle, Darius. As a young man, Mason was a hardworking student with a strong interest in medicine.

After graduating high school, Mason attended Northwestern University and graduated at the top of his class with a BSc in Molecular Biology. Afterward, he was accepted into the Ph.D. program for pharmacogenomics at the University of Chicago.

While pursuing his doctorate, Mason met a young trans woman named Catherine Vaughn at a science expo. The two became fast friends. After witnessing Catherine's difficulties in finding the proper dosage and type of hormone replacement therapy (along with her frustrations with her endocrinologist), Mason began to wonder if pharmacogenomics had a place in transgender medicine.

After achieving his doctorate, Mason accepted a teaching position at UChicago and began researching gene-tailored hormone treatments

for transgender patients. His research proved fruitful, and he was eventually authorized to conduct a small-scale study with patients. Catherine—along with a dozen other trans women and trans men—volunteered for the trial.

It was a resounding success. Trans patients saw results twice as fast as traditional HRT, and the feminizing/masculinizing effects were far more pronounced. As a show of solidarity, Mason had also secretly tested to procedure on himself, resulting in an impressive gain in muscle mass without any of the side-effects of steroid abuse. He began working for Mr. Xu before the Second Dawn program was even conceived, and his experience with feminizing Holden Monroe (aka "Holly") was instrumental in establishing the design of the program. As a self-described sadist, Davis has taken full advantage of his power with the program and uses it to fulfill his cruel desires. Despite his questionable methods, his understanding of the program has given Davis a unique and powerful role during Second Dawn's rise in popularity among the global elite. Mr. Xu has described him as a "blunt instrument," but despite his unpleasant traits, Davis has worked his way into Xu's inner circle and is one of the chief architects of Second Dawn's unparalleled success thus far.

Davis is responsible for overseeing the general operations of the facility known as "Clinic 12," located off the coast of Oregon (there is, in

It was understood that Thomas Monroe would rectify the failed business deal in order to get his son back, but he failed to do so.

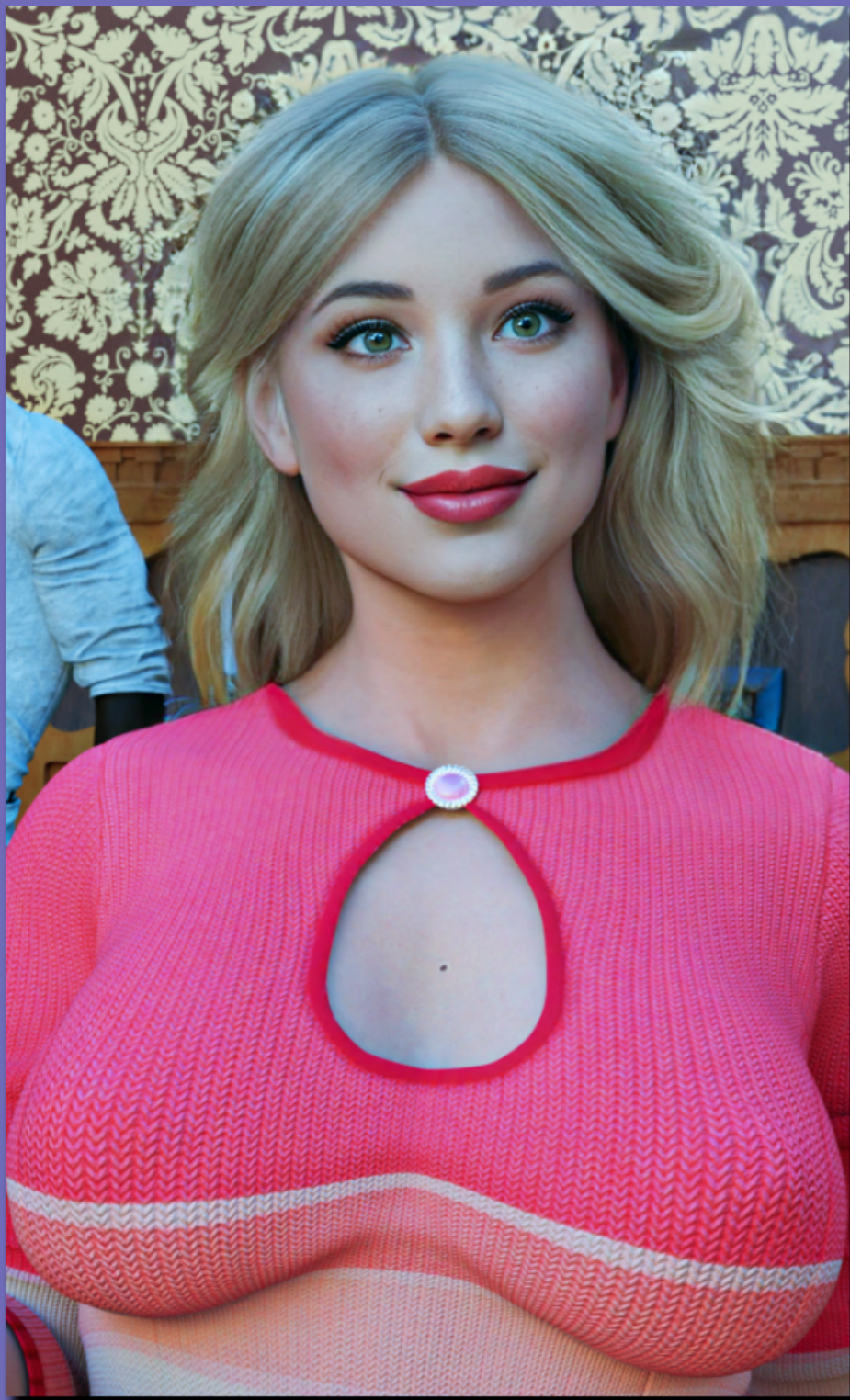

After over a year of captivity, Holly managed to escape with the help of one of her guards, Jason, but they were quickly tracked down and recaptured by Xu's men. At that time, Holly learned that her father had launched an attack against Mr. Xu in order to try to save her, but had failed and been assassinated.

Faced with the prospect of being freed but without money or an identity, Holly was terrified.

Mr. Xu offered her a way out by agreeing to let her stay with him and fully adopt a feminine persona, helping him establish a group called Second Dawn that would capture and feminize other men. Joey worked at the Clinic 12 facility for five years, watching in disgust as men were transformed into women and sold like commodities. Despite his revulsion at what was happening, Joey did his job and kept his mouth shut.

The clinic was a place where young men were captured and subjected to a series of surgeries and treatments designed to feminize them. Mike was horrified by what he saw, but the excellent pay and benefits offered by Second Dawn kept him silent.
