






It's been a while since I worked on a Space Marine and when Indomitus released I really liked the look of the characters in the box.

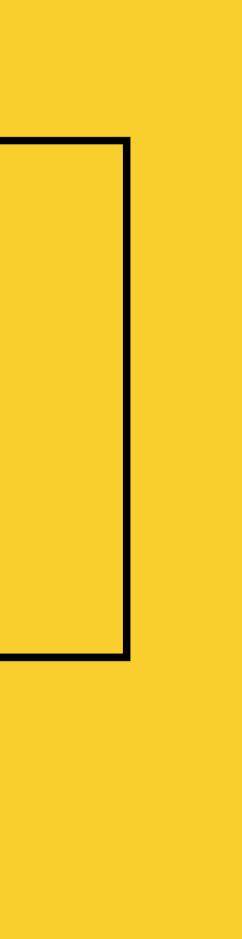
Painting Space Marines is fun to me, when done seldomly, and I enjoyed this paintjob a lot!



## WHY THIS MODEL?

### PAINTS USED IN THIS GUIDE

Kimera: Orange Vallejo Model C:olor: Flat Green, Sunny Skintone, Black







## BASECOAT

The armor was basecoated with Flat Green from VMC.



I'm going to keep this guide fairly short, as this armor was a sort of experiment for me as well, I'm going to share the recipe used in paitning this specific version (different from the final) so that you might use it in case you want it for your paintjobs as I think that, if refined fully, would look really good. It's difficult to explain all that happens in the video, since it's a very "thought process" heavy kind of video. But I think it might be interesting to check it out in case you want to understand what brought me to paint the armor like this and, ultrimately, change it.

I added VMC Sunny skintone to the Flat Green and sketched in the first highlight following the volumes of the miniature. Once blended, I added VMC Light Flesh and used it to create the stronger lights and then pure Light Flesh for the edges and the light glints (top of the helmet, tip of the boots etc).

I also used Kimera Orange mixed with VMC Black to paint in the OSL in the inner parts of the legs and blended it using glazes of VMC Black.
