9 fantastical meals for your heroes to order at a tavern



What's for Dinner...

There are few cooks as clever as those who run taverns catering to heroes.

{Toad Warts} Utterly revolting to look, Toad Warts are a delicacy for anyone that can stomach them. They involve cutting fatty warts from the backs of giant toads, stuffing them with various mushrooms marsh meats, and then steaming them in a reed basket.

{Forge Porridge} A dwarven classic, Forge Porridge takes crushed grains and fruits that have been burned thoroughly and boils them in ale. The finished dish resembles a watery bowl of ashes and charcoal that tastes like a delicious, fruity syrup.



{Dragon's Feast} Dragon's Feast is a bubbling stew made from all of the scraps and leftover ingredients from the day's cooking. Neither delicious nor disgusting, it's an easy dish that ensures nothing goes to waste and there's always something to serve even in the late hours of the night.

{The Old World Salad} You won't find an ounce of meat in this salad. Just ripe berries, crunchy nuts, crisp leaves, and the occasional pixie waiting to cast a sleep spell on you so they can eat the rest of your salad.

{Druid's Stew} Only the oldest and most wrinkly foods get tossed into this massive cauldron which is boiled day and night for over a month. During this time a variety of herbs and spices are added which gives the final dish a surprisingly sweet taste.



{Hairy Foot Pie} Even the lowliest of halfling bakers knows how to bake a perfect Hairy Foot Pie stuffed with savory meats and potatoes. What makes this dish signature though are the thinly cut potato skins that are roasted and sprinkled along the top of the pie crust giving it the semblance of a halfling's hairy foot.

{Ogre's Club} The ogre's club is simply a massive hog or lamb's leg with several carrot "spikes" driven through it that is glazed and roasted over a fire.

{Frost Dragon Tears} Few taverns in all the realm are lucky enough to have the intact ice glands of a frost dragon brought to them by heroes. Those who do, however, are able to use them to freeze various creams and other liquids into refreshingly cold beverages that can be mixed with fruits, nuts, chocolate, and other sweet ingredients.

{Impish Delight} Severed scorpion tail that is dried in a barrel of dangerously hot spices and then grilled over freshly cut pepper. Most cooks won't serve it unless the patron signs a contract stating they understand the risk of eating such a spicy meal.
